



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**Minutes of the Supplementary meeting of PAB held on 29<sup>th</sup> January, 2018 for approval of proposals under the Roadmap for Transforming Education in the State of Jammu and Kashmir under the Centrally Sponsored Schemes of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) and Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA).**

A Supplementary Project Approval Board (PAB) meeting to consider proposals under the Roadmap prepared for Transforming Education in the State of Jammu and Kashmir was held on 29<sup>th</sup> January, 2018.

2. The list of participants who attended the meeting is at Annexure-I.
3. At the outset, Secretary, School Education and Literacy welcomed all the participants. Director (RMSA 1) made a presentation on the proposals received from the State for consideration by the PAB for the FY 2017-18. The proposals received from the State under SSA, RMSA and CSSTE have been appraised by TSG accordingly.

**4. Proposals under RMSA**

1	<b>ICT (Fresh Proposal)</b> The state has proposed 319 Schools for consideration in the priority districts as per the Roadmap under outright purchase model at a cost of Rs. 2041.60 lakh. Of the proposed 319 schools under RMSA, 29 new schools have not been made functional so far, 2 schools have already been covered under the ICT in School Scheme, in 38 schools construction work has not been completed, 2 schools have incorrect UDISE, 2 are Elementary Schools, 8 Schools have less than 15 enrolment and proposal for 1 school is a repetition. Thus, 237 schools were found eligible for ICT scheme. An amount of Rs. 1185.00 lakh for 237 schools was therefore approved.
2	<b>Re-construction of Damaged Schools</b> The State has proposed re-construction of schools which have been damaged during the unrest in the valley in the priority districts. Out of 32 schools proposed by State, 16 schools have been proposed under RMSA. Proposal for re-construction of the 16 Schools with an outlay of 1614.53 lakh was approved. The cost includes, cost of reconstruction of main building, toilet block, drinking water, ramps, kitchen shed and electrification. However, the State needs to submit the unsafe certificates in respect of all the damaged buildings from the competent engineer.
