2. I am further directed to refer to this Department's letter of even no. dated 20.2.2014 thereby releasing an amount of Rs. 37,14,000/- under STSP Head released under General Expenditure Head.


3. In continuation of above, I am directed to convey the sanction of the President to the payment of 1<sup>st</sup> instalment of **Rs. 2,33,44,000/-- ( Rupees Two Crore Thirty Three Lakhs Forty and Four Thousand only) under Capital Expenditure Head to the Secretary, Education Department, Government of Chhattisgarh** towards the expenditure to be incurred on implementation of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Inclusive Education for the Disabled at Secondary Stage(IEDSS) in the State of Chhattisgarh during 2013-14 as per details given in the annexure subject to the condition that necessary top up money has been released by the State Government and the teachers are qualified as per the scheme guidelines. The total release including this sanction for 2013-14 comes to Rs. 3,45,24,000/-.

4. The guidelines issued by the Government of India from time to time regarding monitoring, management, financial control and other procedure would be followed in the execution of the scheme.

5. Any other relevant condition specified in general financial rules 2005 as amended from time to time could be followed.

6. The expenditure involved is debitable to Demand No. 59-Department of School Education & Literacy; Major Head No. '3601'- Grants-in-aid to State Government; 04-Grants for Centrally Sponsored Plan Schemes ; Minor Head - 180- Secondary Education –Other Grants; 08 – Inclusive Education for the Disabled at Secondary School; 08.00.35 – Grants –in-aid (Plan) for the year 2013-2014.

7. The pattern of assistance has been approved by IFD/Ministry of Finance. This sanction is being issued in conformity with the rules and principles of the scheme as approved by the Ministry of Finance.
