Subject: Request for Initiating School leadership Programme of School heads in the State in collaboration with NCSL, NUEPA.

Dear

You will be pleased to know NUEPA has recently established a National Centre for School Leadership (NCSL) with support from Ministry of Human Resource Development under the joint auspices of SSA and RMSA. The major objectives of the Centre are to organize capacity building programmes for school leaders, develop curriculum and course material for designing these programmes and undertake research on school leadership among others. Through that the Centre would provide technical support to State/UT Governments in establishing a comprehensive programme of school leadership development in every State/UT. The NCSL envisages to implement its activities in close collaboration with SSA and RMSA in various States/UTs. The implementation process would involve long term engagement and networking with institutions and professional engaged in school leadership development.

2. While the programme would eventually cover all the States and Union Territories in the initial phase the programme would be implemented in the States of Andhra Pradesh, Chhattishgarh, Gujarat, Himachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Mizoram, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal. The NCSL team at NUEPA has already initiated activities in these states and plans to extend implementation in all the States/UTs in the next phase.

3. I am sure that your state will be keen to participate in this endeavour to build synergy and help develop State-context specific Programmes on School Leadership. In this regard, I request you to collaborate with NUEPA and extend necessary help in the following ways:

- Appoint a Nodal officer from the State who would coordinate the activities at the State level;
- Identify institutions and experts who would get engaged in activities related to leadership development programmes in your State/UT;
- Facilitate NUEPA & international partner in designing State-specific programmes for school leadership in your State/UT.

4. In the above context, I request the State Project Directors of SSA and RMSA and the State Education Department to offer the necessary support to NUEPA and utilize grants earmarked for organization of capacity building programmes for School Heads under the Annual Work Plans for SSA and RMSA.
