Please refer to the above subject and the Ministry's previous letters on this subject. The Ministry has, time and again, impressed upon the State representatives to abide by the time limit for putting up of Annual Reports and Audited Accounts in respect of RMSA. This issue was also discussed at length during the Financial Review meeting held on the 3rd of May, 2012 in Delhi.


2. I regret to say that due to the delay by the States and UTs in submission of the Annual Reports and Audited Accounts, the Committee on Papers Laid on the Table (COPLAT), Rajya Sabha, has, vide O.M. dated 5th July, 2012 (**Annexure-I**) decided to hear view of the Secretary, Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Human Resource Development in person on the above mentioned subject on 13th July, 2012 (Friday). Representatives of Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA) for all States and UTs are also required to attend the meeting for above purpose.

Though, due to shortage of time, the Ministry has requested Rajya Sabha Secretariat to postpone the meeting for the time being and for which the meeting is likely to be held on the first week of August, 2012, the State Government / UT Administration is requested to send the names (by 23rd July, 2012) of the State Government / UT Administration representative who will appear along with the Secretary before the above Committee to explain the delay of laying the reports on the Table of the Rajya Sabha (**list of Secretaries of State is enclosed at Annexure-II**). It is requested that the detailed delay statement (reasons for delay on a month to month justification) and all other required information also be sent immediately to this Department without fail by 23rd July, 2012.



Some States that have sent their Annual Reports in English and not sent the Hindi version of the Annual Report alongwith the detailed Delay statement due to which, the English version reports could not be laid on the Table of the Parliament. It is requested that 60 copies of Annual Reports 2009-10, (8 States as per list enclosed at **Annexure-III**), 60 copies of Annual Report 2010-11, (31 States as per list enclosed at **Annexure-IV**), in English and Hindi as well as the detailed Delay Statement be sent immediately (by 23rd July, 2012) so that necessary action can be taken by the Ministry. Information as per enclosed proforma is also to be sent (**Annexure-V**).

5. The above information at para 3 and para 4 is to be sent by 23rd July, 2012.
