Subject: Online submission of Monthly Progress Report through Project Monitoring System (PMS) under Integrated RMSA (ICT, GH, IEDSS & VE)

Sir/Madam,

A dedicated website for RMSA (Integrated) scheme www.rmsaindia.org was launched by the HRM during the National Conference held on 26th august 2014. In a significant step towards leveraging technology to enhance efficiency and manage the implementation of RMSA, a Project Monitoring System (PMS) has been enabled in the said website, in which on line submission of Monthly Progress Reports, physical as well as financial, can be made by the respective State/UTs.

2. The objective of this process is to ensure an end to end submission of all prescribed progress reports as well as documents for seeking release of funds and to obviate the need for submitting hard copies, except where it is mandated otherwise. Therefore, it is requested that for submission of Monthly Progress Report for the month of August 2014 onwards, the said system may be used. The software is online at www.rmsaindia.org under Programme Management link. The details are available in Reference manual which is annexed herewith. The States may also find useful the real time updates on progress, utilisation as also pending submissions.

3. For verification and authentication, the system has 2 levels, **Level 1:** for feeding the progress report by authorised person preferably in finance unit and **Level 2** for authentication at higher level by SPD/ ASPD as may be authorized by the State. Once Progress Report is finalised and submitted, it cannot be modified.

4. It may also be noted that all the releases by GOI will be uploaded on the system and will be followed by auto generated mail regarding the Sanction Order. Hence there would not be any exchange of letters (in hard copy) on Sanction orders by MHRD.
